



MY CHILD'S NAMED PERSON

WHAT IS A NAMED PERSON?

A named person is someone in you and your child's life who you can turn to for advice and support.

WHO IS THE NP FOR AN INFANT OR CHILD?

The named person for an infant or child of nursery age or younger is usually your health visitor.

WHO IS THE NP FOR A YOUNG PERSON?

The named person for a child or young person is usually their Head Teacher in Primary or Guidance Teacher in Secondary until they are 18.

WHY WOULD I GO TO THE NAMED PERSON?

The named person can help ensure you get the support your child needs before worries grow any bigger.

WHAT DOES THE NAMED PERSON DO?

The named person has knowledge of the help available locally to promote the wellbeing of your child or young person.

WHAT DOES THE NAMED PERSON DO?

The named person will work with you, or arrange a Team with the Family meeting to plan and coordinate the support needed.
