Performance and Audit Committee (PAC)

The Terms of Reference for the PAC state:

The IJB shall appoint the Committee. The Committee will consist of not less than six members of the IJB, excluding professional advisors. At least four Committee members must be IJB voting members and should be drawn from both Council and Health Board appointees.

The Committee may at its discretion set up working groups for review work. Membership of working groups will be open to anyone whom the Committee considers will assist in the task assigned. The working groups will not be decision making bodies or formal committees but will make recommendations to the Performance and Audit Committee.

CHAIR

The Chair of the Committee will be a voting Member nominated by the IJB, noting that the Chair of the IJB cannot also chair the Performance and Audit Committee.

Strategic Planning Advisory Group (SPAG)

With reference to IJB voting members the Terms of Reference of the SPAG state that the meeting should have 2 voting members

• The vice-chair of the IJB



A Health Board Representative if not Vice-Chair Further the Chair should be the vice chair of the IJB
