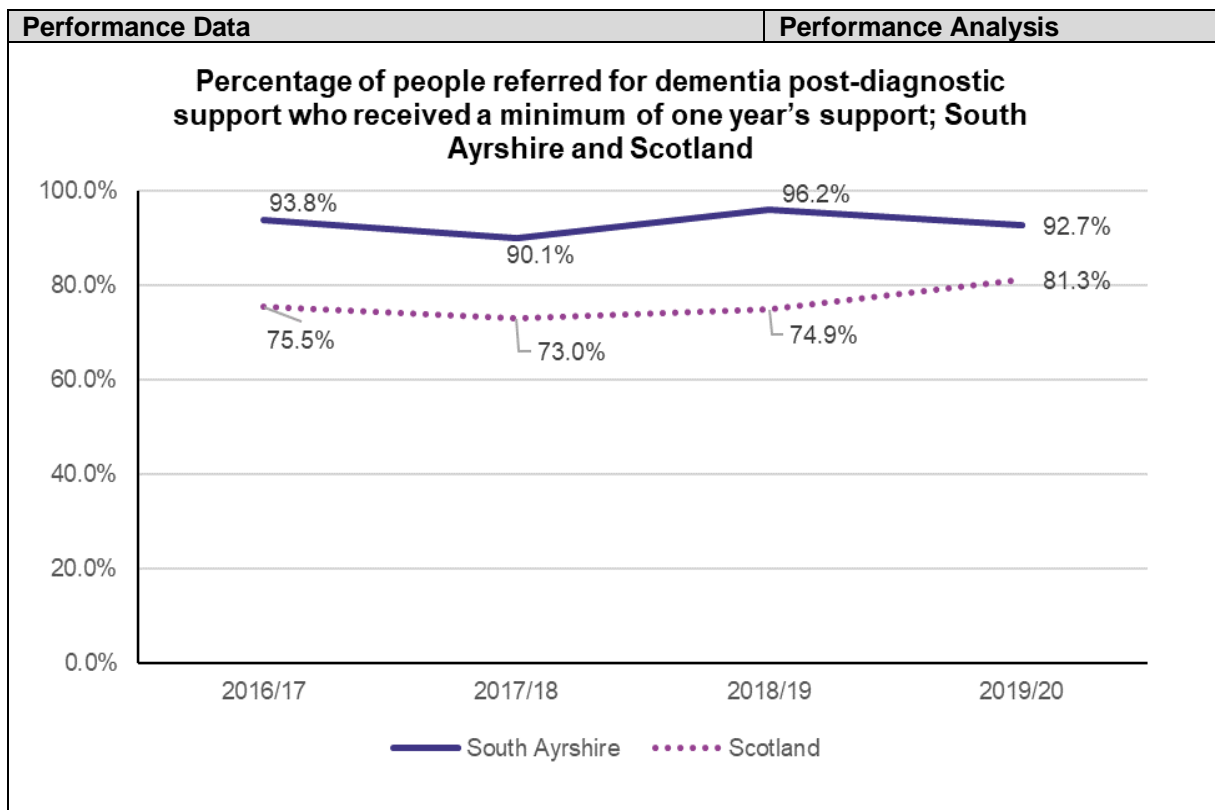

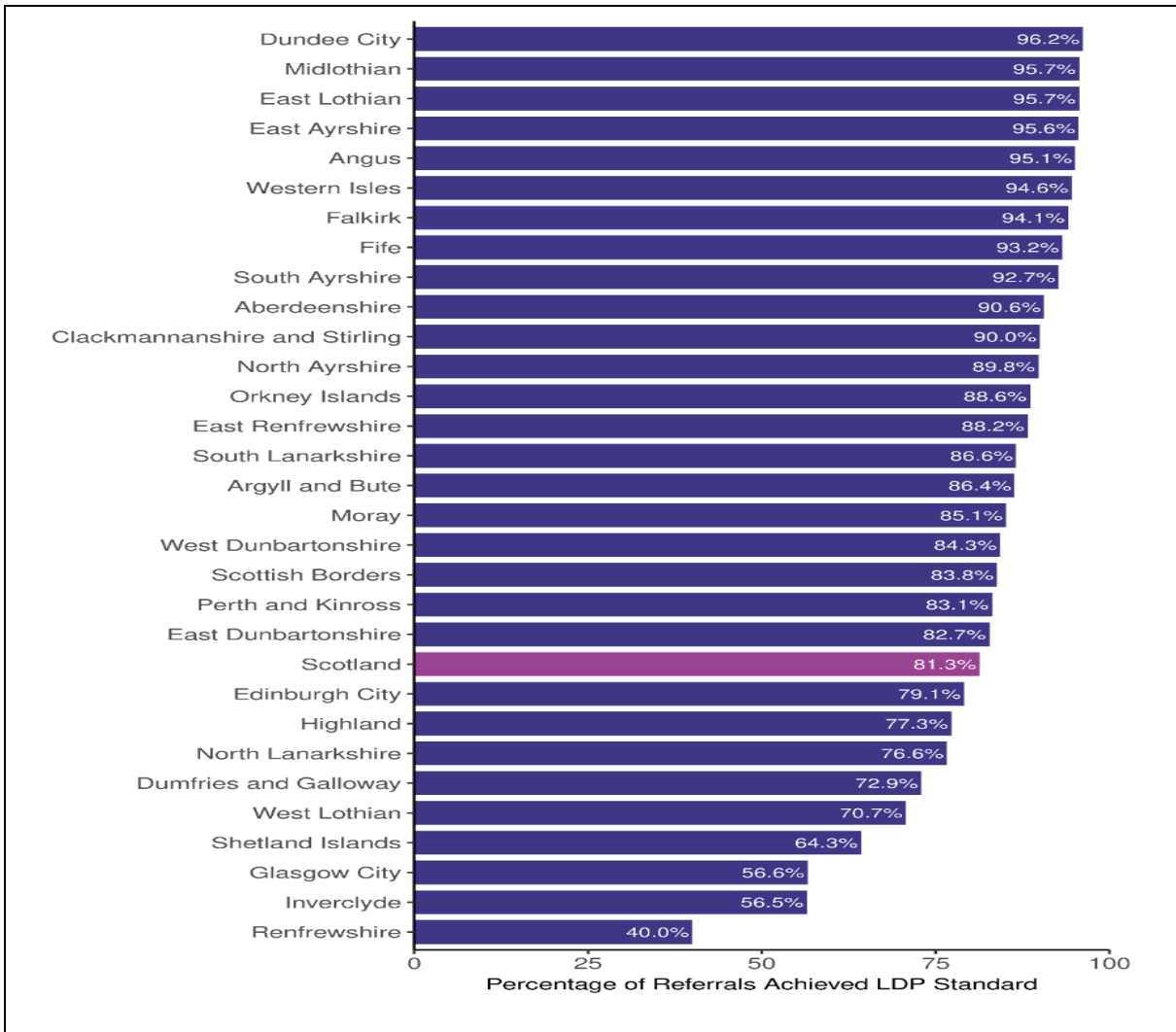

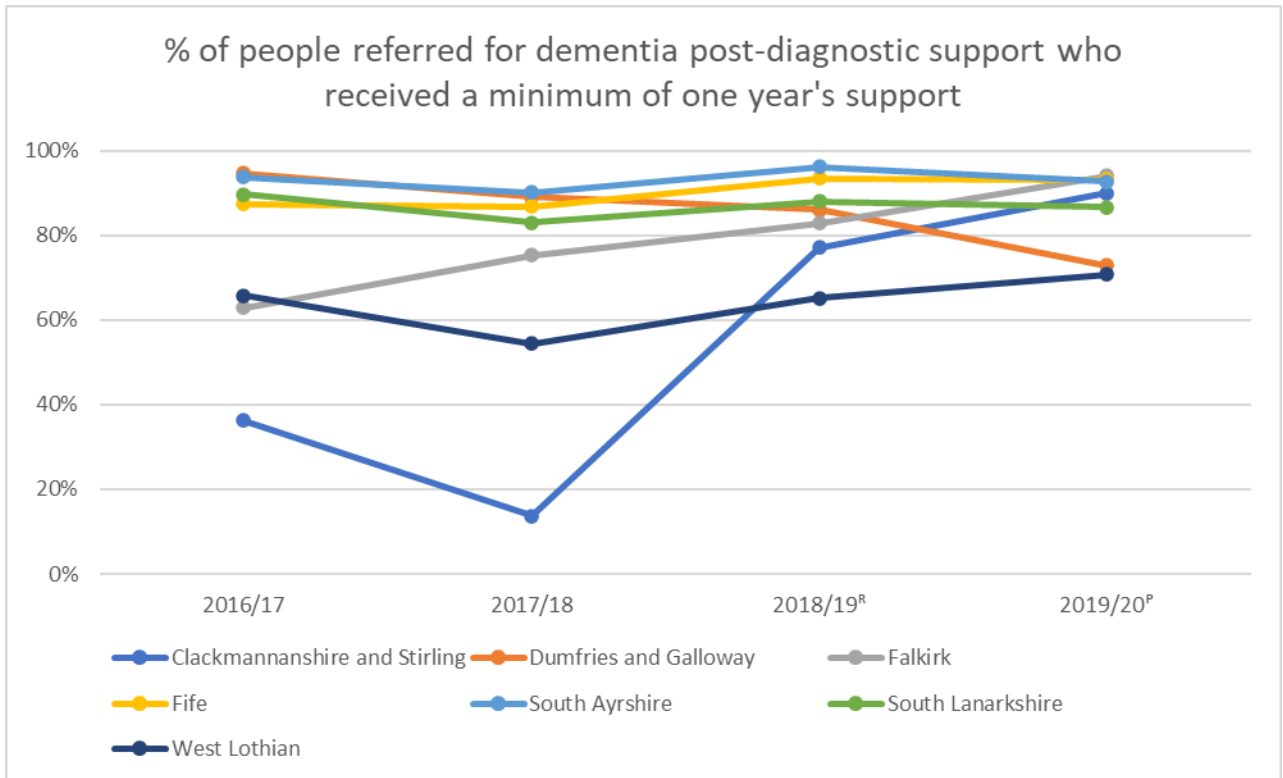




Performance Analysis

South Ayrshire’s performance decreased slightly over the past year from 96.2% to 92.7%, however performance in the SAHCP has been consistently higher than the national average over the past 4 years. South Ayrshire has the 9th highest % of referrals which achieved LDP Standard in relation to this measure in Scotland.

4.1 South Ayrshire consistently performs well when compared with the family group (see below) the percentage of people referred for dementia post-diagnostic support who received a minimum of one year’s support.



4.2 The number of patients currently receiving post-diagnostic support in South Ayrshire is 236. The number of patients who completed or terminated post-diagnostic support in past year (1st July 2021 to 24 June 2022) is 226.
