- 4.2 It is also relevant to note that the Action Plan has been developed in parallel with related processes associated with the statutory review of the Integration Scheme in South Ayrshire. As a result a number of issues are being addressed as part of the Review of the Integration Scheme.
- 4.3 Progress with each of the 31 areas for improvement is detailed in Appendix 1. As Committee members will be aware, the Action Plan was developed relatively recently and as a consequence in many of the areas work is at an early stage or is subject to ongoing dialogue between partner agencies.
